## **Notice of Opening** – Missional Ministry Position (Clergy)

Parishes of St. Lawrence, Portugal Cove, St. Cyprian-St. Mary, Bell Island, All Saints, Pouch Cove, NL

The Rt. Rev. Samuel Rose is accepting applications for a clergy position, full-time, with housing allowance for Missional Ministry with the Parishes of St. Lawrence, Portugal Cove; St. Cyprian-St. Mary, Bell Island; and All Saints, Pouch Cove, NL

## **Missional Model**

Unlike a Traditional Multi-Point Parish which involves amalgamation (pooling of assessment, Parish Council, Weekly Worship with a common cleric at alternate times, etc.), a Missional Model is built and supported by two or more parishes/churches with a common cleric while maintaining their individual identities. A Missional Model supports each other and is missional in its approach to ministry.

This new position has been developed and a Missional Contract has been signed by the said three parishes. All three parishes have strong lay leadership which will aid in the administrative, liturgical, and outreach ministries of each parish.

## **Details of the Missional Contract**

The agreement is for a one-year period with an evaluation process at the end with an option for renewal.

All three parishes will cost-share the stipend/expenses, worship schedule, and pastoral presence based on the following percentages: St. Lawrence 50%, St. Cyprian-St. Mary 25%, All Saints 25%.

Each parish is responsible for its own expenses (Synod Assessment, Housekeeping, and Maintenance)

Each parish agrees to a rebuilding process that will include but is not restricted to the following: Visioning and Planning, Recruitment, and Stewardship Education.

The effective start date is September 1, 2022 (negotiable).

The Ministry Profile is currently being developed and will be available upon request.

Clergy applying from outside the Diocese of Eastern Newfoundland & Labrador should consult with their own Bishop before applying.
