The Rt. Rev. Samuel Rose is accepting applications for the position of **Priest, full-time**. This position will be half-time as the Associate Priest in the Parish of the Ascension working with the Rector and half-time Priest-in-Charge for the Parish of the Good Shepherd. This is a new ministry model between two independent parishes that will cost share a Priest specific to their needs. This model is a one-year contractual position with the possibility of renewal.

The Parish of the Ascension and the Parish of the Good Shepherd share a joint commitment to this new model of ministry and have worked cooperatively to develop the vision. Both parishes have a history of working together on youth programming: offering Godly Play during worship time, sharing a joint youth group for many years, and currently piloting a joint Confirmation program. Bible studies have also been a joint initiative for many years. Both parishes work together with other faith groups in the community through the Mount Pearl Ministerial Association including such things as a weekly community meal and the annual winter festival – The Frosty Festival. Cooperation and flexibility will continue to guide both parishes as they move forward with God's work in the community.

The position consists of **two parishes within the City of Mount Pearl, NL**. There is a **Housing Allowance** provided.

The effective start date is negotiable.
