Ship	Strategic Goal	Individual Goal	Target Completion Date
Deepening Relationships	To invite every baptized person to renew their own personal faith through regular examination of the Baptismal Covenant.		
Deepening Relationships	To further develop our congregations as inclusive, supportive, and non-judgemental communities of faith as we continue to seek and serve Christ in all persons: those already identifying as part of our faith communities; those looking for connections with our faith communities; those against whom wrongs have been done in the name of our faith communities; and the broader community outside of our faith entirely.		

Transforming Discipleship	To enable every baptized person to explore and express their faith by entering and entering again into the fullness of their discipleship of Jesus, and lead others to do the same.		
Renewing Stewardship	To renew our understanding of the true, holistic nature of our stewardship and responsibility to all of God’s creation both individually and together as faith communities.		
Renewing Stewardship	To examine our current environmental footprint in light of the ongoing climate emergency and take action to tangibly reduce the negative impact we as individuals and faith communities are having on God’s creation.		
Engaging Partnerships	Recognizing God in and through others, to partner together across and outside our faith communities to support and engage in shared work, witness, and ministry, and help bring dignity to every human being.
