Projects

Forest Road Pathway Paving: 8844 square feet of pathway were repaved.



Kenmount Road Columbarium Foundation and Walkway: The foundation and surrounding pathway were installed for a new 80 niche columbarium to be installed 2025.



Forest Road Columbarium Foundations: Two foundations for new columbarium were installed. A 80 niche including 10 niches designed to hold 3 urns will be installed in 2025.

Shipping Container: The container stores benches in the winter and a snow blower in the summer. Staff painted the container.



Forest Road tree and Hedge Trimming: Trees overhanging the cemetery building and some columbaria as well as a neighbouring property were trimmed or removed. The hedge leading into the cemetery was trimmed.



Kenmount Road Pond: Plant growth in the pond was removed. The pond buffers stormwater flow from the far side of Kenmount Road running through cemetery property and then along side cemetery property. If plant growth were allowed to remain eventually the pond would cease to exist along with its buffering capacity.
